| Health Insurance         | For an enrollment at TU Darmstadt all exchange students are required to purchase a German statutory health insurance to avoid complication in case of injuries or sickness. German statutory health insurance offers 100 % coverage for doctor-visits, basic dental repair and hospital treatment. The cost is currently approx. 80 € per month for students under the age of 30. |  |
|                          | The validity of the insurance starts always from beginning of a semester, namely, from 1 <sup>st</sup> October in winter semester, or 1 <sup>st</sup> April in summer semester. Hence, the students are only required to buy a travel insurance merely covering from their arrival to the beginning of a semester for visa application.   |  |
|                          | A statutory health insurance can be purchased in Darmstadt. Every statutory health insurance institution charges the same student rate.   |  |
|                          | A German statutory health insurance is an absolute requirement to register at TU  Darmstadt!  |  |

## Accommodation
