WEEK 1: INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS

Professor Rebecca Sanders

This course provides an overview of international human rights. Topics covered include political democracy, women's rights, migrant and refugee rights, poverty and exploitation, and terrorism and war. We will debate whether human rights principles are truly universal and discuss how best to promote human rights compliance around the world.

WEEK 2: E-COMMERCE

Professor Michelle Selnick

This course allows students to learn about online marketing and business methods using internet communications networks and other technologies to initiate, support, and build growth in business.

WEEK 3: ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Professor Chuck Matthews

This course provides students with a foundation for enterprise creation, exploring issues like crafting a business plan, creating organizations in pursuit of your entrepreneurial objectives, effectively leading as an entrepreneur or member of a team, and evaluating new venture concepts.
