





STEP 2: SCREENING OF CANDIDATURE

You will be contacted for the Motivational Interview in English, which will be done online.

STEP 3: SUBMISSION OF FURTHER DOCUMENTS

GMIM Tuition Fee Contributions

Candidates can apply for GMIM Tuition Fee Contributions which are partial discounts covering up to €6,000 and are generally awarded based on the following criteria:

- GMAT/GRE scholarships
- European scholarships
- Alumni scholarships
- Merit-based scholarships awarded to top candidates based on candidates' overall profile, GPA and motivational interview performance

The majority of scholarships are awarded based on merit, more specifically on academic excellence and the applicant's personal motivation for applying to the programme. They are also granted on a first-come, first-served basis.
